In exercise of the powers under section-41 of the United Provinces Excise Act, 1910 (U.P. Act. no IV of 1910), read with section 21 of the Uttar Pradesh General Clause Act, 1904 (U.P. Act. no 1 of 1904) the Excise Commissioner, Uttar Pradesh with the previous sanction of the State Government, makes the following rules with a view to amending the Uttar Pradesh Excise (Settlement of Licences for Foreign Liquor Bonded Warehouses) Rules, 2011 for the grant of licences of Foreign Liquor Bonded Warehouse under clause(d) of section 18 of the said Act of 1910 on fixed licence fee in supersession of all the previous rules published in this behalf to the extent of their inconsistency with these rules.

THE UTTAR PRADESH EXCISE (SETTLEMENT OF LICENCES FOR FOREIGN LIQUOR BONDED WAREHOUSE) (SECOND AMENDMENT) RULES, 2018

Short title and
Commencement

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Excise (Settlement of licences for Foreign Liquor Bonded Warehouse) (Second Amendment) Rules, 2018
