License for the retail sale for consumption "On an off" the premises of country spirit in sealed bottles under the contract supply system in districts under the graduated surcharge system.

NOTE- This license shall not be issued until the security in respect of it paid in full in accordance with provisions of Rule 364 (a) of the Excise Manual.

License for the retail sale of country spirit in pilfer proof sealed standard quart pint and half-pint bottles only at the fixed strength of-----under proof is hereby granted to -----son of ----- at ----- in the district of-----from April 1,-----to march31, subject to the following special and general conditions, the infraction of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, opium or dangerous Drugs. Laws shall render the licensee, liable to the forfeiture of his license and security deposit in addition to any penalties imposed under the above laws.

The license and security deposit shall also be liable to forfeiture in case the information given in the original application for license in form G-28 is found to be wrong in any material respect.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The licensee shall ascertain from one or other of the lists of assessment of monthly license fees exhibited at the Tahsil, warehouse, depot or wholesale shop the amount of the license fee payable by him for the preceding month in accordance with the scale in force and shall pay the same at the sub-treasury of the Tahsil within which his shop is situated on or before the 20th of each month.

2. It shall be competent to the collector, in case of default under the last preceding condition, to recover the sum due under the said condition from the licensee's security deposit provide such security deposit has not been forfeited, and if the said security deposit is insufficient or has been forfeited, to recover the balance due by the licensee as if were an arrears of land revenue.

3. If the amount of security deposit paid in respect of this license falls short at any time due to depreciation of the Government promissory Notes deposited, forfeiture or any other cause, the licensee shall be bound to make up the deficiency within fifteen days of the receipt of a written notice from the Collector.

4. The licensee shall obtain his supplies of spirit, of the strength at which this license authorizes him to sell in reputed quart, pint and half-pint bottles of capacity 26-2/3, 13-1/3 and ounces, respectively labeled sealed with pilfer proof caps and ready for sale, only from a bonded warehouse in his district, or from a wholesale shop situated in the same district and in an area where the rebate of duty is not less than that applying to the place where the retail shop is situated.

5. The licensee or his salesman is strictly forbidden from keeping in any part of the licensed premises caramel, colouring or flavor in material of any kind.

6. The licensee is strictly prohibited under any pretext whatever from tampering with the bottles, their labels, pilfer proof or seals as received from the bonded warehouse, wholesale depot or wholesale shop, and he shall not sell nor possess any spirit other than so received except as provided for in condition 7 following.

7. The premises shall consist of two separate portions in one of which sales in sealed and capsuled whole bottles only shall be permitted and no "on" consumption shall be allowed there. In the other portion only "on" consumption shall be permitted. For this purpose spirit shall be served in special measures equal to 1/8, 1/16 and 1/32 part of a standard quart bottles of 26-2/3 ounces. Only one bottle shall be opened at a time, and no new one shall be opened until the first one is exhausted completely. Spirit exceeding 3/16 of a quart bottle in quantity shall not be served to the same person on the same day. The prices which the licensee may charge for each kind of measure of spirit are detailed in condition 8 below, and he may charge neither more nor less than them. The portion of premises set apart for "On" consumption shall have a signboard affixed at the entrance on which shall be painted "Licensed 'on' premises for the retail sale of country spirit". Similarly, the portion set apart for the sale of whole bottles for consumption 'off' the premises shall have painted "Licensed 'Off' premises for the retail sale of country spirit".

8. The licensee shall, at the time of removing spirit from a bonded warehouse, wholesale depot or whole sale shop, pay to the contract suppliers or licensed wholesale vendor the sum of 56 paise, 50 paise and 44 paise per quart, pint and half-pint bottle for the bottling charge in addition to the cost of and the duty on spirit so removed; provided that on the return of the empty bottles in an undamaged condition to the same bonded warehouse, wholesale depot,

wholesale shop licensee shall be entitled to a returned of 37 paise, 31 paise, and 25 paise per quart pint and half-pint bottle for the empty bottles.

9. At the entrance to the shop a signboard shall be affixed on which shall be painted the name of the licensee, the designation "licensed retail vendor of country spirit" and a list of the quantities and prices in and at which he licensee is authorized by Government to make sales to the public. From the commencement of the year for which this license is granted the list shall be as under:

The license is strictly prohibited from making sales at prices over or under those stated in the aforesaid list.

NOTES—(1) If the sale of only kind of spirit is authorized the column for the price of the other kind should be left blank.

(2) The rate at which purchases are to be paid on return of empty quarts, pins, and half- pints in an under damaged condition shall also be noted on the signboard.

10. The licensee shall be bound to pay the sum of 35 p., 29P., and 23P., for every quart, pint and half-pint, respectively, to any purchaser of spirit from his return, when empty the bottles in which the spirit was purchased provided the bottle is undamaged.

11. The licensee shall not sell to any one person at one time more than one reputed quart bottle, or two reputed pint bottles or four reputed half-pint bottles of plain spirit or one standard quart bottle or spiced spirit or one standard quart bottle or sliced except under a permit granted under Rule 443 of the Excise Manual.

12. Spiced spirit may be sold under the following conditions;

(a) sales shall be made in sealed bottles with the pilfer proof cap and label intact as received from distillery, warehouse, wholesale depot or wholesale shop

(b) spiced liquor shall not be constructed on the premises; and

© the spirit will be accounted for separately.

13. The licensee shall not sell be bound to attend the shop daily for such time as will ensure adequate control of sales and shall maintain a register showing along with his signature, the date and hours of his attendance and keep the same in his shop for inspection of inspecting of inspecting officer. In the event of the licensee being unable to attend the shop on any day, owing to illness or emergent business, the reason for his absence should be stated in the register at is next visit.

14. Full right is vested in Government to enhance the duty, cost price, the scale of license fees, or retail prices and to make alteration in quantities in and strength at which sales may be made to the public at any time during the currency of this license without compensation to the licensee

15. In the case of shops situated in municipalities there shall be only one door opening into a public road unless more are sanctioned by the Collector, or Licensing Board where such board has jurisdiction, In the latter case the additional doors shall have signboard attached to them as in condition 9. Windows opening into the street shall be covered with wire-netting.

16. (a) The licensee, shall provide within licensed premises a reasonable seating accommodation, i.e. a sufficient number of chairs, benches and tables in urban areas and benches or Takhtas in rural areas.

(b) All *Kujjars, Pattals*, etc. shall be removed immediately to a specially erected empty receptacle or bin with a cover kept for this purpose which shall be cleaned at least twice during the sales hours of the shop.

(c)The licensee, as well as the salesman shall be responsible for the proper upkeep and cleanliness of the premises including its drain, etc. which shall also be kept disinfected

17. The shop shall be so constructed that the whole of the interior is visible from the door way.

18. The Gaddi or the bar of the shop where the sales will be made shall not be raised to a height over 3 feet.

19. The licensee or his salesman is strictly prohibited from keeping water on the Gaddi of the shop or within five feet of any other place where spirit is stored or kept for sale.

20. The building in which the shop is situated shall not be used as a place of residence except by the licensee and his family or by his servants

21.The licensee shall maintain an accurate daily account in the following form:

22. The licensee shall, on expiry of his license, report to the Collector the amount of stock, if any, remaining in his possession. Any stock remaining in the license's possession at the expiration of the period fixed by the Collector for the disposal of such stock shall be surrendered to the collector or the District Excise officer or such other officers as the Collector or district excise officer may be appointed in this behalf.

23.In the event of non- renewal of this licensee shall have no claim to compensation whatever.
