License for the manufacture and retail vend of country spirit at-----in the district of ----- from April 1, 19----- up to March 31, 19----- is hereby granted to ----- subject to the following special and general conditions, the infraction of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium, Dangerous drugs Laws shall render the license liable to the forfeiture of his license and advance deposit in addition to pay penalties imposed under the above laws.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The said ----- shall pay to Government the sum of Rs.-----in the following installments. On April -----Rs. -----being the first installment (and addition) Rs. -----being one-sixth of the annual payment, Which if it be not intermediately forfeited for default or breach of some other condition of this license, shall be set off against the eleventh and twelfth installments:

- On May 1,
- On June 1,
- On July 1,
- On August 1,
- On September 1,
- On October 1,
- On November 1,
- On December 1,
- On January 1,

2. The advance deposit made at auction sale under the last preceding section shall, in the event of default of breach of any other condition of this license, not be reclaimed by the licensee.

3. It shall be competent to the Collector on cancelment of the license to re-sell the license at the risk of the licensee, and after deducting the depot, if not forfeited, from any less arising from the re-sale, to recover the remainder if any, from the licensee as if it were an arrears of land revenue.

4. The licensee shall carry on no process of distillation after sunset and before sunrise.

5. The said licensee shall sell no spirit but the produce of his own still.

6. No more than one gallon or six reputed quart bottles shall be sold to person at one time except under a permit granted under Rule 436 of the Excise Manual.

7. The liquor shall be coloured with Sandal wood (Lal Chandan), the colouring being effected in the process of distillation by means of a bag of Sandal wood shaving being placed in the receiver.

8. No noxious or otherwise objectionable substance shall be added to the spirit.

9. The licensee shall not keep on his licensed premises any noxious or poisonous drug or any other similar substance likely to add to the actual of apparent intoxicating quality or the strength of the country spirit.

10. At the entrance to the shop a signboard shall be affixed on which shall painted the name of the vendor and the designation "Licensed manufacturer and retail vendor of country spirit.

11. The shop shall be so constructed that the interior of every public or private bar shall be visible from the doorway.

12. (a) The licensee, shall provide within licensed premises a reasonable seating accommodation, i.e. a sufficient number of chairs, benches and tables in urban areas and benches or Takhtas in rural areas.

(b) All *Kujjars*, *Pattals*, etc. shall be removed immediately to a specially erected empty receptacle or bin with a cover kept for this purpose which shall be cleaned at least twice during the sales hours of the shop.

(c) The licensee, as well as the salesman shall be responsible for the proper upkeep and cleanliness of the premises including its drain, etc. which shall also be kept disinfected.

13. The building in which the shop is situated shall not be used as a place of residence except by the licensee and his family or by a caretaker.
