License for the exclusive privilege of manufacturing and of selling Tari and Sendhi by retail.

The license for the exclusive privilege of manufacturing and selling by retail Tari and Sendhi within the limits specified above in the district of -----from October 1, 19----up to September 30, 19-----, is hereby granted to -----subject to the following conditions, the infraction of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, opium, Dangerous Drugs Laws shall render the licensee liable to the forfeiture of his license and security deposit in addition to pay penalties imposed under the above laws.

1(a) The licensee shall pay to Government an amount equal to two month's license fee as security deposit immediately on the provisional acceptance of bid at a sale by the Collector, one month's License fee Immediately after final acceptance of the bid by the Excise Commissioner or the Collector as the case may be and the balance excluding the last installment of two month's license fees between November 1 and May 1, as may be determined by the Collector. The security deposit will ordinary be adjusted towards the payment of the last installment of two month's license fees, which falls due on June 1, unless it has already been forfeited or any report regarding breach of condition of license; or a prosecution or a report regarding breach of condition of license; or a prosecution or a report for a prosecution under the Excise, opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws is pending against the licensee. In such cases it will be open to the Collector to proceed to realize the last installment of two month's license fee separately.

NOTE—in case the settlement of a shop is effected after May 1, the Collector shall fix the amount of security and the installments payable as license fees in such amounts as he may deem proper.

(b) whenever for any reason the final decision regarding the acceptance of a bid is likely to be delayed, it shall be open to the Excise Commissioner to direct the Collector to settle the shop provisionally with one of the bidders subject to the following further conditions:

(i) The license shall be terminable at will if the sanction is eventually refused and the licensee will not be entitled to claim any compensation or remission of license fee.

(ii) In case the license is so terminated, the licensee will pay an amount proportionate to his bid as license fee for the period during which he retained the license of the shop.

(iii)The conditions in clause (a)regarding the deposit of security and the advance payment of one month's license fee will be applicable to provisional licenses issued under clause (b).

(c) If the security deposited under conditions 1 (a) and 1(b) (iii) is not in cash but consists of Government Promissory Notes, bonds or similar other valuable documents, such security shall on forfeiture vest in Government and shall not be reclaimable by the licensee.

2. It shall be competent to the collector on cancelment of the license to dispose of the privilege conferred thereby at the risk of the licensee and after deduction the deposit, if not forfeited , from any loss accruing to Government, to recover the remainder, if any, from the licensee as if it were an arrears of land revenue.

3. All the shops specified in the list annexed shall be licensed by the said licensee, and the site of no shop shall be changed without the written permission of the Collector or Officer-in charge of Excise.

4.Licenses in Form C. L. 8 duly filled up in respect of locality and period of currency under the signature of the Collector or the District Excise Officer for the manufacture and vend of Tari and Sendhi shall given through the farmer to manufactures and vendors within the limits of the license. The farmer will subsequently fill in other details. The list of such licenses in Form C. L. 8 finally issued by the farmer shall be filled by the Collector's office on or before the 5<sup>th</sup> day after the close of each quarter.

5.The said licensee shall give immediate information to the Collector or Officer- incharge of Excise of any breach of the law or rules relating to excise that he may know, or have reason to believe, to have been committed by any person holding from him a license for retail sale.
