License for the wholesale vend of country spirit in districts under the contract distillery system.

License for the wholesale vend of country spirit is hereby granted to-----at -----in the district of -----from April -----1, 19 , to March 31, 19 ,subject to the following conditions, the infraction of any of which , or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws shall render the licensee liable to the forfeiture of his license in addition to any penalties imposed under the above laws.

**CONDITIONS**

1. No spirit shall be sold at the shop except country spirit procured from the bonded warehouse situated at-----
2. Sales shall be made only to wholesale and retail country spirit vendors holding licenses in the ----- district, provided that the shop of the person to whom the sale is not situated in an area where the rate of duty is higher than that applying to the place where the licensee's wholesale shop is situated.
3. (a) Plain spirit shall be sold at the fixed strengths of 25 • , 35 • or 50 • U.P. as the case may be, subject to a margin of 2 • below the fixed strength. The addition of water or any other substance whatsoever to the spirit is strictly prohibited.  
  
(b) Spiced spirit shall be sold in only sealed bottles with pilfer proof caps intact as received from the warehouse.
4. Such maintain stock of spirit as may be fixed by the Excise Commissioner shall be maintained at the shop by the licensee.
5. Not less than one Imperial gallon of spirit shall be sold to any retail vendor at one time
6. Only standard measures supplied through the Excise Department shall be used.
7. The business covered by this license shall not be sublet or transferred except with the previous sanction of the Collector . the licensee shall not allow any person to conduct sales unless such person has been previously approved by the Collector, and his name is endorsed on the license.
8. Sales shall be made only on the premises for which this license is granted . these premises shall not opened before sunrise and shall be closed by sunset.
9. Sales shall not be made on credit.
10. All issues must be only entered in the pass-book, B.W.L.7,of the retail vendor removing the spirit and the entries duly signed by the wholesale vendor or his representative.
11. At the entered to the shop a signboard shall be affixed on which shall be painted the name of the designation "Licensed wholesale vendor of country spirit".
12. An account of all sales made at the licensed premises shall be kept in the annexed form. Issues to retail shops made by a wholesale vendor must be shown in column 7, 8 and 9.
