License for the retail sale of country spirit in pilfer proof sealed standard quart, pint and half- pint bottle only at the fixed strength of *25 under proof/50° under proof is hereby granted to -----at ----- in the district of -----from April 1,19----, to march 31, 19----, subject to the following special and general condition, the infraction of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, opium or Dangerous Drugs laws shall render the licensee liable to the forfeiture of his license and security deposit in addition to any penalties imposed under the above laws,

The license and security deposit shall also be liable to forfeiture incase the information given in the original applications for license in Form G-28 is found to be wrong in any material respects.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1.The said -----, shall, on or before the fifteenth day of March of the year preceding that for which this license is granted, depositing cash or Government Promissory Notes, as security for the due observance of conditions of this license, the sum of Rs.-----, such sum being equal to twice the amount of license fees livable on average monthly issues of country spirit in imperial bulk gallons, made to his shop during the months of April to December of the excise year preceding that for which this license is granted, in accordance with the scale of license fees notified as having effect from the commencement of this license and as stated hereunder:

2. In the event of default or breach of any other condition of the license the amount deposited shall vest in Government and not e reclaimable by the licensee.

3. The licensee shall ascertain from one or other of the lists of assessment of monthly license fees exhibited at the Tahsil, warehouse, depot or wholesale shop the amount of the license fee payable by him for the preceding month in accordance with the scale in force and shall pay the same at the sub- treasury of the Tahsil within which his shop is situate on or before the 20th of each month.

4. It shall be competent to the collector, in case of default under the last preceding condition, to recover the sum due under the said condition from the licensee's security deposit provide such security deposit has not been forfeited, and if the said security deposit is insufficient or has been forfeited, to recover the balance due by the licensee as if were an arrears of land revenue.

5. The licensee shall obtain his supplies of spirit, of the strength at which this license authorizes him to sell in reputed quart, pint and half-pint bottles of capacity 26-2/3,13-1/3 and ounces, respectively labeled sealed with pilfer proof caps and ready for sale, only from a bonded warehouse in his district, or from a wholesale shop situated in the same district and in an area where the rebate of duty is not less than that applying to the place where the retail shop is situated.

6. The licensee is strictly prohibited under any pretext whatever from tampering with the bottles, their labels, pilfer proof or seals as received from the bonded warehouse, wholesale depot or wholesale shop, and he shall not sell possess any spirit other than so received.

7. The license shall not permit spirit to be consumed "on" his licensed premises.

8. The licensee shall at the time of removing spirit from a bonded warehouse, wholesale depot or wholesale shop pay to the contractor, supplies or licensed wholesale vendor 56p., 50p. and 44 p. in respect of each quart, pint and half-pint respectively in which the spirit is to be removed, provided that, on return of the bottles empty, to the same bonded warehouse, wholesale depot or wholesale shop, undamaged, the licensee shall be entitled to demand from the supply contractors or licensed wholesale vendor the sum of 37p. each quart, 31 p. pint and 25 p. for each half-pint so returned

9. The licensee shall be bonded to pay the sum of 39 p. 29p. and 33 p., for every quart, pint and half-pint, respectively to any purchaser of spirit from his shop who returns when empty, the bottles in which the spirit was purchase, provided the bottle is undamaged.

10. At the entrance to the shop a signboard shall be affixed on which shall be painted the name of the licensee, the designation "licensed retail vendor of country spirit" and a list of the quantities and prices in and at which the licensee is authorized by Government to the public. From the commencement of the year for which the license is granted the list shall be under:

The license is strictly prohibited from making sales at prices over or under those stated in the aforesaid list.

Note—(1) If the sale of only kind of spirit is authorized the column for the price of the other kind should be left blank.

(2) The rate at which purchases are to be paid on return of empty quarts, pints, and half-pints in an under damaged condition shall also be noted on the signboard.

11. The licensee shall not sell to any one person at one time more than one reputed quart bottle, or two reputed pint bottles or four reputed half-pint bottles of plain spirit or one standard quart bottle or spiced spirit or one standard quart bottle or sliced except under a permit granted under Rule 443 of the Excise Manual.

12. The licensee shall not be bound to attend the shop daily for such time as will ensure adequate control of sales and shall maintain a register showing along with his signature, the date and hours of his attendance and keep the same in his shop for inspection of inspecting officer. In the event of the licensee being unable to attend the shop on any day, owing to illness or emergent business, the reason for his absence should be stated in the register at his next visit.

13. Full right is vested in Government to enhance the duty, cost price, the scale of license fees, or retail prices and to make alteration in quantities in and strength at which sales may be made to the public at any time during the currency of this license without compensation to the licensee.

14. In the case of shops situated in municipalities there shall be only one door opening into a public road unless more are sanctioned by the Collector, or Licensing Board where such board has jurisdiction, In the latter case the additional doors shall have signboard attached to them as in condition 10. Windows opening into the street shall be covered with wire-netting.

15. The shop shall be so constructed that the whole of the interior is visible from the doorway.

16. The building in which the shop is situated shall not be used as a place of residence except by the licensee and his family or by his servants.

17. The licensee or his salesman is strictly forbidden from keeping in any part of the licensed premises caramel, colouring or flavouring material of any kind.

18 The licensee or his salesman is strictly prohibited from keeping water on the Gaddi of the shop or within five feet of any other place where spirit is stored or kept for sale.

19. Spiced spirit may be sold under the following conditions;

- (a) sales shall be made in sealed bottles with the pilfer proof cap and label intact as received from distillery, warehouse, wholesale depot or wholesale shop;
- (b) spiced liquor shall not be constructed on the premises; and
- (c) the spirit will be accounted for separately.

20. The licensee, unless exempted by an order of the Collector shall maintain an accurate daily account in the following form.

21. The licensee shall, on expiry of his license, report to the Collector the amount of stock, if any, remaining in his possession. Any stock remaining in the license's possession at the expiration of the period fixed by the Collector for the disposal of such stock shall be surrendered to the collector or the District Excise officer or such other officers as the Collector or district excise officer may be appointed in this behalf.

22. In the event of non-renewal of this licensee shall have no claim to compensation whatever.
