**Licence for the vend of foreign liquor by auction**

Licence for the vend by auction of foreign liquor is hereby granted to \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ in the district of \_\_\_\_\_ for a period of \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ for which Rs. \_\_\_\_\_ has been paid in advance subject to the following conditions, the infraction of any of which, or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws, shall render the licensee liable to the forfeiture of his licence and advance deposit in addition to any the penalties imposed under the above laws.

**CONDITIONS**

1. Sale shall be made only of the abovementioned description of liquor. Country spirit shall not be possessed on the same premises and if the Excise Commissioner has prohibited the sale of any particular foreign brand as being unwholesome, that brand shall not be kept or sold under this licence.
2. The liquor shall be the property other than the auctioner.
3. Sale may be made at any place within the district for which this licence is granted and in any quantity exceeding the limit of retail sale to any person in a single transaction.
4. No liquor shall be sold to –

(a) any soldier, whether in uniform or not, or any member of a soldiers' family or any camp follower except with the special approval of the General Office Commanding the division or the independent Brigade. or the Officer Commanding station and then only such liquor may be sold as shall have been approved by the same authority in consultation with the local excise authorities and specified in the vendor's licence.

(b) any railway servant while on duty any police or excise officer below the rank of police sub-inspector or excise inspector or being in uniform any insane person, any person known, or believed to be intoxicated, or to any person under the age of eighteen years.

**NOTE** - In this condition (1) "soldier" does not include a commissioned officer member of the auxiliary or Indian Territorial forces, a soldier in civil employ, or an Indian soldier absent on leave from his regiment and (2) "camp follower" means a follower (other than a private servant) whether on or all duty, whom the licensed vendor knows or has reason to believe to have a right to be in cantonments.

5. No sale shall be made before sunrise or after 9 p.m.

**NOTE** - A sample of each consignment, not exceeding in bulk one reputed quart bottle can be supplied previous to the auction by the auctioner, on payment to any intending purchaser. In order that the latter may have the opportunity of testing the liquor.
