Licence for the sale of rectified spirit of wine by chemists and druggists

Licence for the sale of rectified spirit of wine is hereby granted to _____ at _____ in the district of _____ on the following conditions. namely:

1. That the privilege extends only to the sale of rectified spirit which means pure rectified spirit imported from foreign territory by sea or manufactured in this country.
2. That no more than ten Imperial gallons (or such larger quantity as the Excise Commissioner may specially authorize) of rectified spirit shall be possessed at a time for purposes of sale.
3. That sale of rectified spirit otherwise than for bona fide medical, industrial and scientific purposes is prohibited.
4. That no more than one reputed pint of rectified spirit shall be sold in one transaction to any private individual, nor more than two reputed quarts to any chemist, medical practitioner, or scientific body, nor more than Imperial gallons to any Government, local fund or municipal hospital.
5. That if the licensee holds any other licence or the sale of foreign liquor on the same premises, he must keep his accounts of transactions under it separate from those under this licence.
6. That the licensee shall keep a correct showing receipts, sales and balance for each day, such account to be open to the inspection of officers authorized to inspect it; and that he shall give enter to the shop to the Collector, the District Excise Officer or any officer of the Excise Department not below the rank of an Excise Inspector at any hour of the day or night.
7. That the licensee shall produce for inspection his licence on demand by officers who are duty authorized to do so.
8. That the licensee shall store all his stock of rectified spirit pertaining to his shop in the premises for which he hold this licence.
9. That the licensee shall not allow any person to conduct sales in his licensed premises unless the name of such person shall have been previously submitted to the Collector for approval and endorsed by his on the licence.
10. That the licence shall have effect from _____ to _____.

A breach of any of the above conditions will render the the licensee liable to the penalties prescribed by the Excise Act (4th of 1910) as well as to the forfeiture of this licence.
