Licence granted to chemist, druggists and medical practitioner for the sale of tonic or medicated wines, manufactured in Uttar Pradesh, as contain 20 per cent or over but under 42 per cent of proof spirit and also those of such tonics or medicated wines, imported from outside Uttar Pradesh, as are not listed in the Schedule of restricted preparations appended to the Medical and Toilet Preparations (Excise Duties) Rules, 1965.

Licence for the sale of tonic or medicated wines, specified above, at the premises known as _____

the district of _____ on the following conditions:

1. That he pays to Government in advance a fee of Rs. _____ for the year or any broken period thereof .
2. That he does not transfer this licence to any other person.
3. That he does not sell under this licence any or medicated wine listed in the Schedule of preparations appended to the Medicinal and Toilet Preparations (Excise Duties) Rules, 1956, if the same is imported from outside Uttar Pradesh .
4. That he does not sell under this licence any wine containing 42 per cent or over of proof spirit.
5. That he sells medicated and tonic wines only at the premises for which this licence is granted.
6. That he sells such wines and preparations for use as tonic or medicine and not as a wine or spirit.
7. That he keeps a correct daily account showing receipts, sales and balance for each day.
8. That he at once produces this licence and the account maintained by him on the demand of the Collector, the District Excise Office or any Officer of the Excise Department not below the rank of Excise Inspector.
9. That he permits any Officer duly authorized in this behalf to enter and inspect his shop at any hour of the day or night.
10. That he shall store all his stock of foreign liquor pertaining to his shop in the premises for which he holds this licence .
11. That he shall allow person to conduct sales in his licenced premises unless the name of such person shall have been previously submitted to the Collector for approval and endorsed by him on the licence.
12. That this licence shall have effect from _____ to _____

A breach of any of the above conditions will render the licensee liable to the penalties prescribed by the Excise Act (4th of 1910) as well as to the forfeiture of this licence.
