Licence for possession and use of spirit denatured with wood naphtha or castor oil and caustic soda.

Licence for the possession and use of spirit denatured with wood or castor oil and caustic soda is hereby granted to _____ at _____ from _____ in the district of _____ to _____ subject to the following conditions and to the subject in the Manual, the infraction of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws, shall render the licensee liable to the confiscation of his licence in addition to any penalties imposed under the above laws.

CONDITIONS

1. The spirit used in the manufacture of transparent soap shall not be less than 60% U.P. in strength and shall contain 5 percent of approved wood naphtha or castor oil and caustic soda. It shall be obtained from a distillery only in Uttar Pradesh.
2. The total quantity of spirit stored on the premises aforesaid shall not exceed at any one time _____ bulk gallons.
3. The quantity allowed to be used in any one year shall not exceed _____ bulk gallons.
4. No spirit shall be used on the premises for the manufacture of any other article than transparent soap.
5. No spirit shall be removed from the premises without the sanction of the Collector.
6. The licensee shall comply with the directions of the Collector as to the manner in which the spirit will be stored.
7. No attempt shall be made to render the spirit fit for human consumption.
8. The spirit shall not sold.
9. Duly authorized Excise Officers shall be allowed access to all parts of the premises for purposes for inspection.
10. The entire produce of one operation for recovery of spirit from the evaporation soap solution shall be collected in the receiver, and the whole of the recovered spirit shall be used in the next succeeding preparation of soap, and no attempt shall be made to collect the recovered spirit in separate portions or fractions.

In the case of spirit denatured with castor oil and caustic soda it must be collected in receivers containing solid caustic soda (1 part for 100 parts of the distillate) so that the distillate will always remain effectively denatured.
11. The spirit vapour pipe from the evaporator shall be securely attached to the condenser and the recovered spirit shall pass through a close metal pipe solder or riveted to the condenser and the cover of the receiver, respectively, and extended nearly to bottom of the receiver.
12. Any spirit sampling pipe shall not have an orifice exceeding one-twentieth of an inch in diameter.
13. The lid and the discharge cock of the receiver shall be secured by locks which are to be kept fastened while spirits are running into the vessel, and at all other times when any spirit remains therein.
14. The Collector, the District Excise Officer or an officer of the Excise Department not below the rank of an Excise Inspector shall be allowed to take samples of the spirit and of materials which contain any spirit.
15. All specially denatured spirit received shall be either added at once to soap in the presence of the Manager or other responsible person or be stored in a vat marked "specially denatured spirit". The lid and the discharge cock of the vat shall be secured by fastenings and spirit must only be removed there from under the supervision of the Manager or other responsible party after it has been entered in the account book and shall be added immediately to soap.
16. No spirit shall be taken away from the premises by any person other than a duly authorized Excise Officer.
17. The keys of all vessels ordered to be locked shall be kept on the premises in charge of the Manager or other responsible person and any such vessels must be immediately unlocked at the requisition of a duly authorized Excise Officer.
18. Particulars of the quantity and strength of every consignment of specially spirit must be entered in a book on the day of receipt. All transactions shall be correctly entered from day-to-day in the same book and a correct balance struck after each day's withdrawals from the stock. The book shall be accessible to the Excise Officers who visit the premises and every pass which accompanied spirit received shall be retained and delivered to the Officer who next visits the premises.
19. The licensee shall execute a bond in Form F.L. 20 for such amount as may be fixed by the Collector for the privilege of storage and use of the specially denatured spirit and due observance of the conditions of this licence and the rules contained in the Excise Manual.

NOTE- This licence should be corrected before issue so as to apply for the particular kind of denatured spirit for which it is issued.
