Register to be maintained by foreign liquor vendors

The register will be divided in to four parts:

Part i- To consist of remarks by Inspecting Officers.

Part ii – This will show all receipts by the licensee. Entries should be made only on the dates on which supplies are received. A separate line should be given to each consignment and if the consignment consists of liquors of various kinds a separate line should be given to each of liquor also.

Part iii- This part is reserved for sales Where more than one licence is held for the same premises separate sale accounts must be maintained for the business done under cover of each licence. Similarly, in the case of licences for wholesale vend of foreign liquor both to licence vendors and club and messes (F.L.-2) separate sale accounts must be maintained for sales (1) to licensed vendors and (2) to the clubs and messes. Sales to licensed vendors should be entered in Part – iii of the register, and sales to the clubs and messes in a separate sale account- book. For this purpose separate sale account- books in the same form as Part iii of this register will be available on payment. One such book should be used by every holder of a licensee (in Form F.L.2) for entering the sale to the clubs and messes and by every licensee. Who holds more than one licence for the same premises, for entering the sales under cover of each additional licence.

Part iv- This should show the total receipt of each kind of liquor during the day, the total sales and the balance at the end of the day. The total sales will be obtained by totaling the entries for the days, as shown in Part iii and the separate sale register maintained for each kind of licence or for sales to the clubs and messes under a wholesale licence which authorizes such sales.
