*Licence for retail vend of Rum obtained at concessional rate of duty*

Licence for retail vend of Rum obtained at concessional rate of duty in force \_\_\_\_\_ is hereby granted to \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ in the district of \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ for which Rs. \_\_\_\_\_ has been paid in advance, subject to the following conditions, the infraction of any of which or conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous Drugs shall render the licensee liable to forfeiture of his licence and advance deposit in addition to any penalties imposed (under the above laws).

**CONDITIONS**

- (1) Sales of only rum obtained at concessional rate of duty shall be made at the place approved for the purpose by Officer Commanding of the unit and entered on the licence and not at any other place. The licensee shall not establish a second place of vend without another separate licence for the purpose.
- (2) The licensee shall obtain bottled Rum up to the quantity covered by the permit issued by the Collector of the district.
- (3) The Rum will be sold for consumption to those members of Military troops (other than 'entitled personnel') who have been authorised by the Officer Commanding of the Unit to use such Rum. The maximum quantity upto which Rum can be allowed to each member shall be fixed by the Officer Commanding.

**NOTE (1)** "Entitled Personnel" will be those who have been classified as such by the Officer Commanding but will not include Commissioned and other Senior Officers.

**(2)** "Entitled Personnel" can obtain Rum on production of ration cards, granted by the Officer Commanding up to the quantity allowed to them for consumption at their residence.

4. The sale of Rum to Military Personnel other than 'Entitled Personnel' will be conducted in the presence of an officer (deputed by the Officer Commanding of the unit) who will put his signature in the sale register under the column specified for the purpose, in token of having distributed the allotted quantity of Rum in his presence.

5. A copy of the permit issued by the Collector of the district authorising the licensee to obtain Rum for the unit, shall be kept by him at the licensed premises.

6. Sales shall be made only at such hours as may be fixed by the Officer Commanding and endorsed on the licence.

7. The licensee shall pay licence fee monthly in advance on the basis of sales made in the previous month at the prescribed rate subject to a minimum of Rs. 5 in any month. The fee for first month shall be fixed at Rs.

8. The licensee shall maintain regular and accurate accounts in the prescribed register (F.L.25\_A and F.L.25\_B) to be obtained from the Collector's office on payment and shall produce the same for inspection on demand by officers duly authorised to do so and shall furnish to the Collector such returns of sales as may be required.

9. The licensee shall produce for inspection his licence on demand by officers who are authorised to do so.

10. The licensee shall store all his stock of Rum pertaining to his shop in the premises for which he holds the licence.

11. The saleable strength of Rum shall not be weaker than 250 U.P. and reduction of the strength is prohibited.

12. Sales of Rum shall be allowed in bottles of capacity of 750 millilitres and millilitres per quart and pint bottles.

13. No drugs or deleterious substance shall be added to the liquor nor shall any adulterated or deteriorated liquor be stored or sold.

14. No transfer or sub-lease (whether entire or partial) in the business covered by the shop licence shall be made, nor shall the licensee be allowed to enter into private partnership in the business covered by the licence.

15. The licence shall not allow any person to conduct sales in his licensed premises unless the name of such person has been previously submitted to the Collector for approval and endorsed by him in the licence.

16. The licensee shall not employ any person suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, for any purpose in his licensed premises.

17. Persons of bad character shall not be allowed to resort to the shop. intoxication, gambling or disorderly conduct shall not be permitted in the premises.

18. Alteration of the original label under which concessional Rum has been received is also prohibited.

19. No woman shall be employed, either with or without remuneration in the licensed premises.
