Licence for retail vend of foreign and foreign spirits and foreign fermented liquors under the military "canteen" system.

Licence for retail vend of spirits and fermented liquors classified as "foreign is hereby granted to \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ in the district of \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ for which Rs. \_\_\_\_\_ has been paid in advance, subject to the following special and general conditions, the infraction of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws, shall render the licensee liable to the forfeiture of his licence and advance and advance deposit in addition to any penalties imposed under the above laws.

**NOTE** – Country spirit or white rum may also be sold under this licence provided supplies are obtained on payment of duty at the prescribed rate and the contract price fixed for the area in which the unit is stationed from a bonded warehouse situated within the district, or, if there is no such warehouse in the district from the warehouse authorized to make supplies to retail country spirit vendors within the district.

### SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Sales of the above mentioned description of liquors only shall be made at the canteen or place appointed for the purpose by the military authorities and not any other place. The licensee shall not establish a second place of vend without another separate licence.

**NOTE** – It is not necessary for canteen licensees to take out a licence in the case of troops on manoeuvres, the line of march or at temporary stations when called out in aid of the civil power: provided that sales at these place are incorporated in the accounts kept at the main licensed place.

1. Spirituous or fermented liquors to be sold under this licence shall not be stored in any premises other than those endorsed on the back of the licence.

1. No liquor shall be sold to persons other than those attached to the regiment to the regiment for which this licence is granted or duly authorized under the regulations of the Army to use such canteen.
2. No greater quantity than two imperial gallons or twelve quart or twenty-four reputed pint bottles shall be sold to any person at one time.
3. Sales shall only be made at such hours as may be fixed by the military authorities.
4. The licensee shall maintain regular and accurate accounts in the prescribed register (Form F.L.25) to be obtained from the Collector's office on payment and shall produce the same for inspection on the requisition of any officer authorized by Government to demand their production and shall furnish to the Collector such returns of sales as may be required.
