any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws shall render the licensee liable to the cancellation of his licence and
forfeiture of his security deposits in addition to any penalties imposed under the above law.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. (a) The licensee shall pay to Government an amount equal to two months, license fees as security immediately on the provisional acceptance of bid at
a sale by the Collector and balance excluding the last two installments of license fee in the following installments as may be fixed by the Collector. The security
deposit will ordinarily be adjusted towards the payment of eleventh and twelfth installments unless it has already been forfeited or any report regarding breach of
condition of license of a prosecution under the Excise Opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws is pending against the licensee. In such cash case it will be open to the
Collector to proceed to realize the last two installments separately

(b) Whenever for any reason the final decision regarding the acceptance of a bid is likely to be delayed it shall be open to the Excise Commissioner to
direct the Collector to settle the shop provisionally with one of the bidders subject to the following further conditions :

(i) The license shall be terminable at will if the sanction is eventually refused and the licensee will not be entitled to claim any compensation or remission
of license fee.

(ii) In case the license is so terminated the licensee will pay an amount proportional to his bid as license fee for the period during which he retained the
license of the shop.

(iii) The conditions in clause (a) regarding the deposit of security will be applicable to provisional licenses issued under clause (b)

(c) If the security deposit under conditions 1 (a) and 1(b) (iii) is not in cash but consists of Government Promissory Notes, bonds or similar other valuable
document such security on forfeiture shall vest in Government and shall not be reclaimable by the licensee.

2. It shall be competent to the Collector on cancelment of the license, to re-sell the license at the rise of the licensee and after deducting the advance
deposit in case it has not been forfeited from any loss arising from the re-sale to recover the balance if any from the licensee as if it were an arrear of land revenue.

3. The licensee shall obtain his supplies of Bhang only from a bonded warehouse establish in his district and in an area where the rate of duty is not less
than that applying to the place where the retail shop is situated.

4. The licensee shall provide himself with accurate scales and weights which may be prescribed by the Excise Commissioner and shall use such weights
only and no other and keep the same in good condition.

5. At the entrance to the shop a signboard shall be affixed on which shall be painted the name of the vendor. the designation "Licensed vendor of Bhang".

6. The licensee is strictly prohibited from possessing or selling packets which are unsealed.

7. The licensee is strictly forbidden from possessing or selling at his licensed premises, prepared Bhang, generally known as ghoti bhang bhang
emulsion or majum.

8. The licensee must personally supervise the weighment of portions of Bhang and have a sufficient number of such portion wrapped in paper and sealed
in his presence and kept ready for sale to the public, provided that the number of such portion sold to any person at one time except under a permit granted under
rule of the Excise Manual shall not exceed, in total weight, 10 Totals

9. the licensee shall possess and sell only that Bhang which has been lawfully obtained from a bonded warehouse Admixture of Bhang or doing anything
with regard to it which might change its appearance, potency, quantity or weight is strictly prohibited.

10. The license-holder shall not permit the consumption of Bhang in any from in his shop or other premises in his occupation.

11. Any portion of the stock of Bhang which may be declared by any officer, duly authorized in this behalf, to be unfit for consumption shall be
surrendered for destruction.

12. The license-holder, unless exempted by an order of the Collector, shall correctly maintain a daily account in a printed register to be obtained from the
Collector's officer on payment.

The account shall be written up as soon as the transaction for each day have been closed.

13. The licensee shall on expiry of his license, report to the Collector the amount of stock, if any, remaining in his possession. Any stock remaining in the licensee's possession at the expiration of the period fixed by the Collector for the disposal of such stock shall be surrendered to the Collector or District Excise Officer or such other officer as the Collector or the District Excise Officer may appoint in this behalf.

14. If in any district the Collector has reasons to consider that the sales of any particular shops are extraordinarily high due to malpractices on the part of the licensee, he may, after giving an opportunity to the licensee to explain restrict the total annual issues to that shop to such a quantity as he considers reasonable, making due allowance for such factor as the issues during previous normal years, general fall in consumption the natural diversion of custom from neighboring shops that may have been close, etc and when the total issues are thus restricted, he will allow only proportionate issues from month to month.

15. In the case Government decides any enhancement in the issue price of Bhang in the year following the expiry of this license the Collector may restrict the issues to any shop in the months of February and March to a quantity which he may consider reasonable having regard to the actual held by the licensee on January 31, and the issues to the shop in previous months. This quantity shall not be allowed to exceed, except for very exceptional reasons, the normal demand at the shop during these months in the last three normal years.

16. The licensee is strictly forbidden from having recourse to any form of blandishment or inducement or the customers with a view to increase his sales. Providing of any sort of amusement or recreation such as music (including gramophone music) dance, radio programmers or any other variety of entertainment or on behalf of the licensee in order to attract customers to the shop is also not permitted.
