Licence for the retail vend of opium is hereby granted to ----- at ----- in the district of ----- from April 1, 19 \_\_\_\_ to March 31, 19 \_\_\_\_ subject to the following condition of any of which, or a conviction for any offence under the Excise , Opium or Dangerous Laws shall render the licensed salesman liable to the forfeiture of his licence and security deposit in addition to any penalties imposed under the above laws.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. The said salesman shall deposit with Government the sum of Rs. \_\_\_\_\_ in each cash or in Government promissory notes of equivalent value as security deposit for due fulfillment of the conditions of this licence and observance of rules frames or ordered passed by the Excise Commissioner for opium shops under States Management.
2. The security deposit made under the last preceding section shall in the events of default or breach of any conditions of this licence, or of any rule framed or order passed by the Excise Commissioner for the proper management of Opium shop under the system of direct management, not be reclaimable by the licensed salesman.

**NOTE----** If Government promissory notes or other security have been deposited the following shall be substituted for the preceding clause.

In the event of default or breach of any condition of this licence or the non-observance of any rule or orders referred to above, the Government promissory notes or other security deposited shall vest in Government and shall not be reclaimable by the licensed salesman.

3. The licensed salesman shall make sales only to persons holding permit in Form O-5 O-6 or O-7 or to their authorized agents holding a written authority in Form O-14 or to person holding a special order in writing of the Collector of the district for purchase of opium for use on Government account.
4. Opium sold during any month to persons holding permit in Form O-5, O-6 shall not exceed the quota fixed in the permit nor shall sale of lapsed quota of opium be made in any succeeding month. Sales to persons holding permit in Form O-7 shall not exceed the quantity fixed in the permit. The details of such sales shall invariably be entered by the licensed salesman in the Schedule appended to the respective permit and duly initialed and dated . Sales up to the

quantity specified in the special order of the Collector shall similarly be entered on back thereof and duly initialed and dated.

5. The licensed salesman shall not permit the consumption of opium in any form in his shop or other premises in his occupation.
6. The opium shall not be adulterated.
7. The licensed salesman shall obtain his supplies of opium only from the Government treasury of the district in which the shop is situated and in accordance with the rules and procedure laid down by the Excise Commissioner. Supplies can only be obtained on application by the licensed salesman himself or on presentation of his written authority by the assistant salesman acting on his behalf. The licensed salesman shall secure the initials of the officer –in-charge treasury against every issue of opium taken by him in the pass-book in Form O-13 supplied to him.
8. The licensed salesman shall sell no opium, but such as has been obtained in the manner prescribed in the preceding condition and he shall not receive nor have in his possession opium obtained otherwise. All opium so obtained shall be stored in the shop in which sale is permitted by this licence.

9. The licensed salesman shall be provided with accurate scales and weights which may be prescribed by the Excise Commissioner and shall use such weights only and no other and keep the same in good condition.
10. The licensed salesman shall be supplied with a signboard, which shall be affixed at the entrance of the shop and on which shall be printed or painted the words "licensed shop for sale of opium to permit – holders" and a list of the quantities in and prices at which he is authorized by Government to make sales of opium to the permit – holders. From the commencement of the year for which this licence is granted the list shall be as under :

The licensed salesman is strictly prohibited from making sales at prices over or under those stated in the above list.

11. No opium should be sold except in sealed packets corresponding to the weight prescribed in the last preceding condition. The licensed salesman must personally supervise the weighing of portion of opium and have a sufficient number of such portion wrapped in paper and sealed in his presence and keep them ready for sales to the permit-holders at the price authorized. The licensed salesman is strictly prohibited from selling packets which are unsealed or which contains quantities of opium other than those prescribed for sale in his license.
12. The licensed salesman shall be bound to attend the shop daily throughout the sale hours in order to conduct the sales himself as to insure the adequate supervision and control of sales by the assistant salesman, if any, posted to the shop. He shall maintain a register showing along with his signature, the date and hours of his attendance and keep the same in his shop for inspection of inspecting officers.

In the event of the licensed salesman being unable to attend the shop on any day owing to illness or any unavoidable cause the reason for his absence should be stated in the register at his next visit.

13. The licensed salesman shall correctly maintain a daily account in form O-15 showing the receipts and sales of opium each day and the balance in stock.
14. The licensed salesman shall also maintain regularly a register of sales of opium to permit-holders in Form O-16.

**NOTE----** The entries in this register shall be made immediately at time of making sales to permit-holders. After the days

is sales are over, the total and balance should be struck and entries made in register O-15 in appropriate columns.

15. The license may be surrender by the licensed salesman on his giving one month's notices to the Collector.
