Licence for sale of medicinal opium to permit-holders by head salesman/salesman of State-managed shops within prohibition areas of Uttar Pradesh.

Licence for the sale of medicinal opium to permit-holders is hereby granted to-----at----- in the district of_____ from April, 1, 19__ to March 31,19__ subject to the following conditions, the infractions of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous, Drugs Laws shall render the licensed salesman liable to the forfeiture of his licence and security deposit in addition to any penalty imposed under the above laws.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The said salesman shall deposit with Government the sum of Rs. ----- in cash or in Government promissory notes of equivalent value as security deposit for due fulfilment of the condition of this licence and observance of rules framed or orders passed by the Excise Commissioner for the proper management of opium shops under State-management.
2. The security deposit made under the last preceding section shall, in the event of default or breach of any conditions of this license, or of any rule framed or orders passed by the Excise Commissioner for the proper management of opium shops under the system of direct management, not be reclaimable by the licensed salesman.

NOTE--- If Government promissory notes or other security have been deposited shall be substituted for the preceding clause.

In the event of default or breach of any conditions of this licence or the non-observance of any rule or orders referred to above, the Government promissory notes or other security deposited shall vest in Government and shall not be reclaimable by the licensed salesman.

3. The licensed salesman shall make sales only on the premises for which the licence is granted. He shall make sales only to person holding permit in Form D.D.8 or D.D.9 or to their authorised agents, holding a written authority in Form D.D.11.
4. Medical Opium sold during any month to persons holding permit in Form D.D.8. or D.D.9 shall not exceed the quota fixed in the permit nor shall sale of lapsed quota of medical opium be made in any succeeding month. The details of such sales shall invariably be entered by the licensed salesman in the Schedule appended to the respective permits and duly initialed and dated.
5. The licensed salesman shall not permit the consumption of medicinal opium in any form in his premises.

6. The medicinal opium shall not be adulterated.
7. The licensed salesman shall obtain his supply of medical opium only from the Government treasury in the district in which is licensed premises are situated and in accordance with the rules on the subject and procedure laid down by the Excise Commissioner. Supplies can only be obtain on application by the salesman licensed himself. The licensed salesman shall secure the initials of the officer-in-charge. Treasury against every issue of medicinal opium taken by him in the pass-book in the Form D.D.12 supplied to him.
8. The licensed salesman shall sell no medicinal opium, save as has been obtained in the manner prescribed in the preceding condition; and shall not receive nor have in his possession medicinal opium obtained otherwise. All medicinal opium so obtained shall be stored in the licensed premises in which sale is permitted by this licence.
9. The licensed salesman shall be proved with accurate scales and weights which may be prescribed by the Excise Commissioner and shall use such weights only and no other and keep the same in good condition.

10. The licensed salesman shall be supplied with a signboard, which shall be affixed at the entrance of the licensed premises and on which shall be painted the words "Licensed premises for sale of medicinal opium to permit - holders" and a list of the quantities in and prices at which he is authorized by the Government to make sales of medicinal opium to permit - holder. From the commencement of the year for which this licence is granted the list shall be as under :

NOTE - The amounts worked out at the current prescribed rate shall be got filled in by the licensed salesman.

The licensed salesman strictly prohibited. from making sales at prices over or under those stated in the above list.

11. No medicinal opium shall be sold except in sealed packets corresponding to the weights prescribed in the last preceding condition. The licensed salesman is strictly prohibited for selling packets which are unsealed or which contain quantities of medicinal opium other than those prescribed for sale in his licence.

12. The licensed salesman shall correctly maintain daily account in D. D. 13 showing the receipts and sales of medicinal opium each day he balance in stock.

13. The licensed salesman shall maintain regularly a register of sales of medicinal opium to permit - holder in form D.D. 16.

Note-The entries in this register shall be made immediately at the time of making sales to permit - holder. After the day's sales are over the total and should be struck and entry made in register D. D. 13 in appropriate columns.

14. The licensed salesman shall maintain, in addition to the two registers mentioned above, a register in form S.M. 14 of daily sale - proceeds of medicinal opium.

15. The license may be surrendered by the licensed salesman on his giving to on month's notice to the Collector.
