License to manufacture wine in a licensed Vintnery

License is hereby granted to \_\_\_\_\_ resident/s of \_\_\_\_\_ on payment of license fee of Rs. 500 (Rupees five hundred only) authorizing him/them (1) to manufacture wine in the premises situated at \_\_\_\_\_ and (2) to use, keep or have in his/their possession any material, still utensil, implement or apparatus whatsoever for the purpose of manufacturing wine, as previously approved by the Excise Commissioner, U.P., subject to the provisions contained in the U.P. for the security of excise revenue and for regulating the from time to time be made by the Excise Commissioner, U.P for the security of excise revenue and for regulating the manufacture, sale, supply and price of wine. The infraction of any of the rules hereinbefore enumerated or of conditions specified below shall involve forfeiture of the license in addition to such other penalties as may be prescribed under the U.P. Excise Act, 1910.

This license shall be valid for the Excise year.

The vintner shall apply to the Collector on or before February 28 in each year for the renewal of his license for the Excise year following:

**CONDITIONS**

1.The vintner shall use only such materials for manufacturing wines which have been previously approved by the Excise Commissioner, Uttar Pradesh and shall maintain such vessels in the vintnery, duly numbered, which are according to the specifications prescribed by the Excise Commissioner for the manufacture etc. of wine.

2.The vintner shall deposit as security a sum of Rs. 2500(Rupees two thousand five hundred only) in Government Promissory Notes or Government Securities of equivalent market value for due fulfillment of relevant rules and all conditions of license. The notes or other securities shall be endorsed to the Collector of the district by designation.

3.On the event of default or breach of any conditions or non-observance of any rule referred to above, the security deposit made in accordance with the last preceding condition shall vest in this State Government and not be reclaimable by the vintner.

4.The vintner shall allow all Excise Officers of or above the rank of an Excise Inspector to visit the vintnery, at all hours of day and night, to inspect the premises to check the accounts and pass books and measure finished and unfinished wines and ascertain their specific gravity.

5.The name of all persons engaged in the manufacture and disposal of wine shall be duly endorsed on the license, on approval of Collector.
