To _____ at _____ in the district of _____ from April 1, to March 31, subject to the following special and general conditions, the infraction of any of which or a conviction for any offence under the Excise, Opium or Dangerous Drugs Laws shall render the licensee liable to the forfeiture of his licence and security deposit in addition to any penalties imposed under the above laws.

The licence and security deposit shall also be liable to forfeiture in information given in the original applications for licence in Form G-28 is found to be wrong in any material respects.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The said _____ shall, on or before the fifteenth day of March of the year preceding that for which this licence is granted, deposit, in cash or Government Promissory Notes, as security for the due observance of the conditions of this licence, the sum of Rs. _____, such sum being equal to twice the amount of licence fees leviable on average monthly issues of country spirit, in imperial bulk gallons, made to his shop during the months of April to December of the excise year preceding that for which this licence is granted in accordance with the scale of licence fees notified as having effect from the commencement of this licence and as stated hereunder.

2. In the event of default or breach of any other condition of the licence the amount deposited shall vest in Government and not be reclaimable by the licensee.
3. The licensee shall ascertain from one or other of the lists of assessment of monthly licence fees exhibited at the Tahsil, warehouse, depot or wholesale shop the amount of the licence fee payable by him for the preceding month in accordance with the scale in force and shall pay the same at the sub-treasury of the Tahsil within which his shop is situated on or before the 20th of each month.
4. It shall be competent to the Collector, in case of default, under the last preceding condition, to recover the sum due under the said condition from the licensee's security deposit, provided such security deposit has not been forfeited and if the said security deposit is insufficient or has been forfeited to recover the balance due by the licensee as if it were an arrear of land revenue.
5. The licensee shall obtain his supplies of spirit, of the strength at which this licence authorizes him to sell, only from a bonded warehouse in his district, or from a wholesale depot or wholesale shop situated in the same district and in an area where the rate of duty is not less than that applying to the place where the retail shop is situated.
6. The licensee shall possess and sell spirit only of the fixed strength for which the shop is licensed and of the colour prescribed by the Excise Commissioner. The addition of water or any other substance whatsoever to the spirit is strictly prohibited.

7. The licensee shall provide himself with the standard measures prescribed by the Excise Department namely, 1/4 quart, 1/8 quart, 1/16 quart and 1/32 quart, and shall keep the same in good condition.
8. The licensee is permitted to make sales for consumption either "on or off" the premises.
9. At the entrance to the shop a signboard shall be affixed on which shall be painted the name of licensee, the designation "Licensed retail vendor of country spirit" and a list of the quantities in and prices at which the licensee is authorized by government to make sales to the public. From the commencement of the year for which this licence is granted the list shall be as under.

NOTE- if the sale of one kind of spirit only is authorized, the column for the price of the other kind should be left blank.

10. The licensee shall not sell to any one person at one time more than one quart bottle of 35° under proof or 13/10 quart bottles of 50° under proof, or one sealed quart bottle of spiced country spirit except under a permit granted under Rule 443 of the Excise manual.

N.B.- in Tahsils of Sittarganj and Khatuna of Naini Tal District, the limit of retail sale for 25° U.P. of plain country spirit is also one quart bottle.

11. Spiced country spirit may be sold under the following conditions:
 - (a) sale shall be made in sealed bottles with pilfer proof cap and label intact as received from the distillery, warehouse, wholesale depot or wholesale shop;
 - (b) spiced liquor shall not be consumed on the premises; and
 - (c) the spirit will be accounted for separately.

12. The licensee shall be bound to attend the shop daily for such time as will ensure adequate control of sales, and shall maintain a register showing, along with his signature, the date and hours of his attendance and keep the same in his shop for inspection of inspecting officer. In the event of the licensee being unable to attend the shop on any way owing to illness or emergent business the reason for his absence should be stated in the register at his next visit.

NOTE- The register need not be maintained when the licensee is illiterate.

13. Full right is vested in Government to enhance the duty, cost price, the scale of licence fees, or the fixed retail prices, and to make alteration in the quantities in and strength at which sale may be made to the public at any time during the currency of this licence without compensation to the licensee.
14. In the case of shops situated in municipalities there shall be one door opening into a public road unless more are sanctioned by the Collector, or Licensing Board where such Board has jurisdiction. In the latter case the additional doors shall have signboards attached to them as in condition 9. Windows opening into the street shall be covered with wire-netting.
15. (a) The licensee shall provide within licensed premises a reasonable seating accommodation, i.e. a sufficient number of benches, chairs and tables in urban areas and benches or Takhtas in rural areas.
 (b) All kujjars, pattals, etc. shall be removed immediately to a specially erected empty receptacle or bin with a cover kept for this purpose which shall be cleaned at least twice during the sales hours of the shop.
 (c) The licensee as well as the salesman shall be responsible for the proper upkeep and cleanliness of the premises including its drains, etc. Which shall also be kept disinfected.
16. The shop shall be so constructed that the whole of the interior shall be visible from the doorway.
17. The Gaddi or the bar of the shop where the sales will be made shall not be raised to a height over 3 feet.
18. The building in which the shop is situated shall not be used as a place of residence, except by the licensee and his family or by his servants.

19. The licensee or his salesman is strictly forbidden from keeping in any part of the licensed premises caramel, colouring or flavoring material of any kind.
20. The licensee or his salesman is strictly prohibited from keeping water on the Gaddi of the shop or within five feet of any other place where spirit is stored or kept for sale.
21. The licensee, unless exempted by an order of the Collector, shall maintain an accurate daily account in the following form:

N.B- *fractions of a bottle should be disregarded.

22. The licensee shall, on expiry of his licence, report to the collector the amount of stock, if any, remaining in his possession. Any stock remaining in the licensee's possession at the expiration of the period fixed by the Collector for the disposal of such stock shall be surrendered to the Collector or the District Excise Officer or such other officer as the Collector or District Excise Officer may appoint in this behalf.
23. In the event of non-renewal of this licence, the licensee shall have no claim to compensation whatsoever.
