APPENDIX I
FORM F.L. 15-A
(RULE 2)

Licence granted to a wholesale dealer for the wholesale vend of notified restricted spirituous preparations .

Licence for the wholesale vend of notified spirituous preparations at the premises known as -----
-----is granted to -----at-----in the district of -----on the
following conditions -

1. That he shall pay to Government in advance a fee of re. 1 for the year or for any lesser period.
2. That he shall not transfer this licence to any other person.
3. That he shall sell under this licence the notified restricted spirituous preparations in untampered original packing and not in fractional quantities to
 - (i) another wholesale dealer holding a similar licence in Form F.L. 15-A ; or
 - (ii) a retail dealer holding licence in Form F.L. 15-B ; or
 - (iii) a registered medical practitioner holding doctor's permit in Form F.L. 15-C upto the quantity allowed.
4. That he shall get no supplies of the notified restricted spirituous preparation except under a permit in Form R.M.P.-5 and against a pass issued by a proper authority.
5. That all sales made shall be covered by a transport pass in Form R.M.P-6 duly got signed by the Excise Inspector of the Circle (proper Officer).
6. That he shall keep a correct daily account showing receipts, sales and the balance for each day for each of the articles covered under this licence, separately.
7. That he shall produce this licence and the account maintained by him at once on demand by the Collector, the District Excise Officer or any Officer of the Excise Department not below the rank of an Excise Inspector exercising jurisdiction in the area.
8. That he shall permit any officer duly authorised in this behalf to enter and inspect his shop at any hour of the day or at night.
9. That he shall store all his stock of notified restricted spirituous preparations covered by this licence and pertaining to his shop in the premises for which he holds this licence.
10. That he shall not allow any person to conduct sale in his licensed premises unless the name of such person has been previously submitted to the Collector for approval and duly endorsed on the licence.
11. That this licence shall have effect from -----to-----.

A breach of any of the above conditions will render the licensee liable to the penalties prescribed under the U.P. Excise Act, 1910 (Act No. IV of 1910) as well as to the forfeiture of this licence.
