APPENDIX II

(RULE 2)

Licence granted to a retail dealer for the retail vend of notified restricted spirituous preparations.
Licence for the retail vend of notified Restricted Spirituous Preparations at the premises known as -----is
granted -----at-----in the district of -----on the following conditions :

1. That he shall pay to Government in advance a fee of Re. 1 for the year or for any lesser period.
2. That he shall not transfer this licence to any other person.
3. That all sales of notified restricted spirituous preparations shall be covered by a cash or a credit memo issued in Form R.M.P-7 (Appendix VI)
4. That he shall not sell on any one day any of the notified restricted spirituous preparation as such to any person in excess of the quantity fixed by the Excise Commissioner from time to time as the limit of private possession, or as an ingredient of a mixture prepared in accordance with the prescription of a registered medical practitioner, or as an ingredient of a patent medicine.

NOTE--- Mixture may include pigments, paints or lotions, or the like made in accordance with the prescription of a registered medical practitioner.

5. That he shall get no supplies of notified restricted spirituous preparations except under a permit in Form R.M.P-5 and against a pass in Form R.M.P-6 issued by a proper authority.
 6. That he shall keep a correct daily account showing receipts, sales and the balance for each day for each of the articles covered under this licence, separately.
 7. That he shall produce this licence and the account maintained by him at once on demand by the Collector, the District Excise Officer or any Officer of the Excise Department not below the rank of an Excise Inspector exercising jurisdiction in the area.
 8. That he shall permit any officer duly authorised in this behalf to enter and inspect his shop at any hour of the day or at night.
 9. That he shall store all his stock of notified restricted spirituous preparations covered by this licence and pertaining to his shop in the premises for which he holds this licence.
 10. That he shall not allow any person to conduct sales in his licensed premises unless the name of such person has been previously submitted to the Collector for approval and duly endorsed on the licence.
 11. That this licence shall have effect from -----to-----.
- A breach of any of the above conditions will render the licensee liable to the penalties prescribed under the U.P. Excise Act, 1910 (Act No. IV of 1910) as well as to the forfeiture of this licence.
