Annual permit granted to Registered Medical Practitioners for the purchase, transport and possession of any notified restricted preparation for use as an ingredient of a mixture or a patent medicine dispensed only on his own prescription.

The monthly quota for doctors paying sales-tax may be 50 per cent more than those not paying sale-tax.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The notified Restricted Spirituous Preparation shall not be sold neat as an ingredient of a mixture or a patent medicine

2. dispensed in accordance with the doctor's own prescription.

NOTE-- Mixture may include pigments, paints or lotions, or the like made in accordance with the prescription of a Registered Medical Practitioner.

2. The purchase of the notified restricted spirituous preparation shall only be made from licensed wholesale dealers or manufacturers.

3. The permit is personal to the doctor to whom it is granted and shall not be transferred.

4. The Registered Medical Practitioner, when purchasing the preparations in the same town in which he practices, shall produce his permit(F.L. 15-C) before the supplier. In case of purchase from other places, the Registered Medical Practitioner shall mention the number of F.L. 15-c permit of the Registered Medical Practitioner concerned shall send, within three days of the receipts of the consignment by him, his F.L. 15-C permit to the District Excise Officer of his district for endorsement of the notified Restricted Spirituous Preparations in appropriate column in the sale permit. The manufacture or the wholesale dealer shall enter the particulars of each of the notified Restricted Spirituous Preparation sold by him in appropriate column of the permit.

5. The permit is granted with effects from----- and shall expire on 31st March-----unless renewed for the ensuing year.

6. The cost of the permit-book will be Rs. 1 which shall-be paid by the Registered Medical Practitioner and deposited in a Government Treasury.
